

ARTICLE WRITING CONTEST (APRIL, 2022)

3. All committee members must submit an undertaking that they will follow the Academic Statute of JGEC.
4. Utilization certificates of all the student related fund/non-Governmental fund must be submitted to Accounts/Assistant Procter/Principal. All the Utilization certificates must be signed by the committee members.
5. The students committee may be dissolved if the integration of faculty, students and administrative issues are not synchronized and the Discipline of the Institute is at stake.




